**BLUETONGUE**

The whole of Yorkshire and Lancashire is now included in the Blue Tongue Protection Zone. We strongly urge vendors from Cumbria to continue to forward their stock at Bentham as we are confident that full market values will continue to be realised. Whilst Cumbrian farmers for the time being cannot buy we view this as a case of a small door temporarily closing but a larger door (ie the rest of the country) being left wide open for business. If you have any concerns please do not hesitate to contact one of our auctioneers. DEFRA are hopeful that the Cumbrian area will be included in the Protection zone at the end of the month.
