AUCTIONEERS REPORT (Russell Steer):- The considerable drop in price of finished beef over the last few months is beginning to have a knock on effect in the calf ring, with the quality Continental x bulls most affected. Matthew Robinson, Holmescales topped the trade at £295 with his great shaped Blue Bull. Black & White Calves remained a good trade with buyers for all strengths and sizes. Stronger, partly weaned calves were £13 -£182, medium calves £7 -£13, younger or plainer calves from £1 -£7.
