AUCTIONEER'S REPORT (Russell Steer):- More calves forward than expected in Yorkshire Show week met a level trade. Continentalx hfrs looked the dearest on the day with the first calf in the ring setting the trade. Pam Parker's month old British Blue heifer changed hands with Stephen Hodgson, Greenodd, for the top heifer price of £315. Colin Wilson, Witherslack, topped the bulls at £355, with another at £332. Black and Whites varied; better calves were keenly sought after, particularly a pair of fortnight old Dairy Shorthorn cross bull calves from James Ashton, Bracken Hill, which made £142 and £115 respectively. Many older weaned calves were also in demand, with Robert Burrow of High Snab selling seven to a top of £178 and averaging £137.
